April 25 – May 6, 2022





Online survey


Students completed the online survey during class time








Two thirds of students identify as White, whereas a fifth identify as Indigenous






A third of students identify as Indigenous, with a quarter identifying as First Nations, and 1 in 10 identifying as Métis




Q2. Do you identify as First Nations, Métis, and/or Inuit? If yes, select all that apply. Framework: All respondents




2 in 5 said they are not religious. A quarter are Christian, followed by 1 in 10 indicating Indigenous Spirituality






Half of responding students identify as Male and half identify as Female






Three quarters of students identify as Straight and 2 in 10 identify as 2SLGBTQ+











Majority of White students are non-Indigenous, whereas majority of Indigenous and White & Indigenous students identify as First Nations.




Q2. Do you identify as First Nations, Métis, and/or Inuit? If yes, select all that apply. Framework: All respondents




4 in 9 White students and White & Indigenous students are not religious, whereas 4 in 9 Indigenous students are of Indigenous Spirituality.




More than 1 in 10 White & Indigenous and Indigenous students are non-binary.






4 in 5 White students are straight. The proportion of White & Indigenous and Indigenous students who identify as 2SLGBTQ is doubled that of White students.

In general, 1 in 10 or less students consider themselves to be a person with a disability.





A quarter of Indigenous students live with mother only.










Q12b/Q13b. Please check the highest level of education this person completed. Select only one answer. Framework: All respondents
